

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

 - 5. All equipment must be securely anchored to the establishment.
- 6. The interior of the establishment must be 7 to 8 feet wide, inclusive, have a ceiling height of at least 6 feet and be at least 24 feet long, as measured from the front interior wall to the back of the establishment.
 - 7. One 5-pound ABC fire extinguisher must be mounted in public view.
- 8. A ramp or lift must be provided for access to the establishment if services are provided to persons with disabilities.
 - 9. No services may be performed while the establishment is in motion.
- 10. Sleeping provisions must not be placed or maintained in the working area of the establishment.
- 11. Containers in the establishment must consist of galvanized stainless steel or other noncorrosive material not including glass.
- 12. All chemicals in the establishment must be stored in secured cabinets, separate and apart from other articles or equipment in the establishment.






PROHIBITED ACTS; PENALTIES; ENFORCEMENT

Prohibited Acts

NRS 644A.900 Unlawful practices without license or certificate of registration; exceptions.

- 1. It is unlawful for any person to conduct or operate a cosmetological establishment, an establishment for hair braiding, a school of cosmetology, or any other place of business in which any one or any combination of the occupations of cosmetology are taught or practiced unless the person is licensed in accordance with the provisions of this chapter.
- 2. Except as otherwise provided in subsections 4 and 5, it is unlawful for any person to engage in, or attempt to engage in, the practice of cosmetology or any branch thereof, whether for compensation or otherwise, unless the person is licensed or registered in accordance with the provisions of this chapter.



The citation also must inform the person of the provisions of subsection 2. A separate citation must be issued for each violation. If appropriate, the citation may contain an order to cease and desist.(b) Upon finding that a person has violated the provisions of NRS 644A.900, the Board shall assess an administrative fine of:
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- (3) For the third or subsequent violation, \$2,000.
- 2. To appeal a finding of a violation of NRS 644A.900, the person must request a hearing by written notice of appeal to the Board within 30 days after the date on which the citation is issued.

Be advised that the Nevada State Board of Cosmetology ("Board") has been notified of your unlawful activities in the State of Nevada.

Pursuant to Chapter 644A of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS"), the practice of cosmetology, including the practice of shampoo technology, esthetics, advanced esthetics, hair design/braiding, and/or nail technology, is subject to the protection and regulation by the State. Further, the State has entrusted the power to regulate and enforce the practice of cosmetology to the Nevada State Board of Cosmetology.

Chapter 644 of the Nevada Revised Statutes and Nevada Administrative Code regulates the practice of Cosmetology and all the branches thereof. The State of Nevada requires any cosmetology service (or branch thereof) be performed by a licensed individual and only inside a licensed establishment. By offering, advertising, or providing any esthetic services inside your residence, without proper licensing, you are not in compliance with these provisions.

Predicated on the aforementioned, this correspondence shall serve as a demand that Jada Love immediately cease and desist from providing any esthetic services and operating a salon without being properly licensed by the Board. This includes, but is not limited to, eyelash extensions.

Be advised that NRS 644A.850 authorizes the Board to impose additional fines of up to \$2,000 per violation upon any person who violates the provisions of NRS 644A.850, which delineates the grounds for disciplinary action by the Board. Additionally, NRS 644A.950 states that any person who violates any provisions of NRS Chapter 644A is guilty of a misdemeanor. In the event you fail and refuse to comply with this cease and desist demand, the Board may seek any and all disciplinary action against you.

This correspondence shall not waive any of the Board's rights and/or remedies, all of which are specifically reserved.

PROHIBITED ACTS; PENALTIES; ENFORCEMENT

Prohibited Acts

NRS 644A.900 Unlawful practices without license or certificate of registration; exceptions.

- 1. It is unlawful for any person to conduct or operate a cosmetological establishment, an establishment for hair braiding, a school of cosmetology, or any other place of business in which any one or any combination of the occupations of cosmetology are taught or practiced unless the person is licensed in accordance with the provisions of this chapter.
- 2. Except as otherwise provided in subsections 4 and 5, it is unlawful for any person to engage in, or attempt to engage in, the practice of cosmetology or any branch thereof, whether for compensation or otherwise, unless the person is licensed or registered in accordance with the provisions of this chapter.

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Open Meeting Law

PRESENTATION TO THE NEVADA STATE BOARD OF COSMETOLOGY

APRIL 10, 2023

APPLICABILITY OF THE OPEN MEETING LAW

- The OML applies to meetings of public bodies. NRS 241.016(1).
- "Public Body" is defined as "Any administrative, advisory, executive or legislative body of the State or a local government consisting of at least two persons which expends or disburses or is supported in whole or in part by tax revenue" NRS 241.015(4).
 - Administrative, legislative, and executive organizations may all be "public bodies."
 - Includes subcommittees created by public bodies. NRS 241.015(4).

OPEN MEETING LAW (NRS CHAPTER 241)

- "In enacting this chapter, the Legislature finds and declares that all public bodies exist to aid in the conduct of the people's business. It is the intent of the law that their actions be taken openly and that their deliberations be conducted openly." NRS 241.010(1).
- "The exceptions provided in this chapter, and electronic communication, must not be used to circumvent the spirit or letter of this chapter to deliberate or act, outside of an open and public meeting, upon a matter over which the public body has supervision, control, jurisdiction or advisory powers." NRS 241.016(4).
- The spirit and policy behind the OML favors open meetings and any exceptions thereto should be strictly construed. *McKay v. Board of Supervisors*, 102 Nev. 644, 730 P.2d 438 (1986).

OPEN MEETING LAW (NRS CHAPTER 241): Key Requirements

- AGENDA: Must provide full notice and disclosure of discussion topics and any possible action. Sandoval v. Board of Regents, 119 Nev. 148, 67 P.3d 902 (2003).
- **Decisions:** Deliberation and action(s) must be properly noticed and taken openly. NRS 241.010.*Note: Action is only taken by the body as a whole. Members have no individual decision-making powers and may only speak on behalf of the body if authorized to do so during an open meeting. NRS 241.015(1).
- **Subcommittees:** To the extent a multimember group is appointed by a public body and given the task of making recommendations to that public body, that group is also a "public body" subject to the OML. NRS.015(4).

WHAT IS A MEETING?

NRS 241.015 says:

- **Quorum** of members of a public body *gathering* together with:
- **Deliberation** toward a decision; and/or
- **Action**: which means making a decision, commitment or promise over a matter within the public body's supervision, jurisdiction, control or advisory power.
- A quorum is a simple majority of the total body (NRS 241.015(5)); action requires majority vote of members present (NRS 241.015(1)).
- A gathering of a quorum at a social function is **not** a meeting **as long as** there is no deliberation or action.
- An attorney-client conference on potential and existing litigation is **not** a meeting **as long as** there is no action.

WHAT IS A MEETING?

- Serial communications or "walking quorums" can constitute a constructive meeting.
- A constructive quorum can exist with less than a quorum speaking together at any given time if opinions are relayed between members.
- Email pitfalls "Reply all" email chains can constitute a meeting.
- Example of a constructive quorum: Two members of a five-member public body discuss how they intend to vote on an issue and why. One of those members then has that same discussion with a third member, including how both the first two members intend to vote and why. A quorum (three members) has deliberated on an issue outside of a meeting.

Meeting Notice and Agenda: NRS 241.020

- Time, place and location of meeting
- List of locations posted
- Agenda consisting of a clear and complete statement of the topics scheduled to be considered
- Action items clearly denoted as "for possible action"
- Public comment at beginning/end or before any action item
- Posted at office of the public body or location of meeting and 3 other separate, prominent places within Nevada
- Posted at public body website and at www.notice.nv.gov
- Posted no later than 9 AM of the third working day before the meeting

Meeting Notice and Agenda: What is "Clear and Complete?"

- Agenda items must be **clear and complete**. NRS 241.020(2)(d)(1).
- A higher degree of specificity is necessary for topics of substantial public interest. Sandoval, 119 Nev. at 154-55, 67 P.3d at 906. Factors to consider include:
 - Does the topic generate public comment?
 - Does the topic generate debate among the members of the body?
 - Does the topic generate media interest/coverage?
- Note: Agenda items such as "member comments" and "reports" are problematic in that these invite discussion and possible deliberation on topics that are not set forth on the agenda. Be careful to ensure that any topic that is raised should be included on a future agenda before any discussion can ensue.

Meeting Notice and Agenda (continued)

- Name and contact information for person the public may request supporting materials from and locations where the supporting material is available
- If any portion of the meeting will be closed to consider the character, alleged misconduct or professional competence of a person, then the name of the person
- If the public body will consider whether to take administrative action regarding a person, then the name of the person
- Notification that items on the agenda may be taken out of order, may be combined for consideration, and may be removed from the agenda or delayed for discussion at any time
- Any restrictions on comments by the general public

Additional Requirements

- Public bodies shall make reasonable efforts to assist and accommodate persons with physical disabilities desiring to attend. NRS 241.020(1).
- Notice to persons who have requested notice of meetings pursuant to NRS 241.020(3)(c).
- Additional notice requirements for consideration of character, misconduct, competence, or physical or mental health: 5 days personal service or 21 days certified mail. NRS 241.033. *This would not apply to passing remarks.
- An emergency meeting may only be called where the need to act upon a matter is truly unforeseen and circumstances dictate that immediate action is required. NRS 241.020(9). Circumstances include (1) Any impairment of the health and safety of the public (i.e., COVID) and (2) disasters caused by fire, flood, earthquake or other natural causes.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- One copy of the agenda, any supporting materials, and the recording of a public meeting must be provided at no cost to a member of the public requesting them and at least one copy made available at the meeting. NRS 241.020(6); NRS 241.035(2).
- Supporting materials must be available to the public when provided to public body members. NRS 241.020(7).
- Meeting must be recorded or transcribed. NRS 241.035(4).
- Minutes must be kept in conformance with NRS 241.035 and include:
 - Date, time and place of meeting;
 - Members in attendance;
 - Substance of all matters proposed, discussed or decided; and
 - Substance of remarks made by any member of public or their written remarks if requested.

EXCEPTIONS- NRS 241.030

- Closed sessions may be held to by any public body to consider:
 - Character or Alleged misconduct;
 - Professional competence;
 - Physical or mental health of a person;
 - With some exceptions, or to prepare, revise, administer, or grade examinations administered on behalf of the public body; or
 - to consider an appeal by a person of the results of an examination appeal by a person of the results of an examination administered on behalf of the public body.
 - Litigation Strategies: to either (1) provide information to the Board regarding potential or existing litigation or (2) to advise the Board as it deliberates toward a decision on matter in pending or existing litigation. However, any **action** decided by the Board, must be on record in a public meeting.
- Closed sessions may **NOT** be held:
 - To discuss the appointment of any person to public office or as a member of a public body. NRS 241.030(4)(d); see also City Council of City of Reno v. Reno Newspapers, Inc., 105 Nev. 886, 784 P.2d 974 (1989).
 - To consider the character, alleged misconduct, or professional competence of an elected member of a public body, or a person who is an appointed public officer or who serves at the pleasure of a public body as a chief executive or administrative officer or in a comparable position.

Public Comment Pitfalls

- Restrictions must be reasonable "time, place, and manner" restrictions. NRS 241.020(d)(7). This means NO:
 - Halting comment based on viewpoint of speaker;
 - Halting comment upon belief defamation is occurring; or
 - Halting comment critical of a public official.
 - However, presiding officer may halt comments that become unduly repetitive or that stray from the scope of a specified agenda topic for which comment is offered, or halt conduct that is willfully disruptive. See *Kindt v. Santa Monica Rent Control Bd.*, 67 F.3d 266 (9th Cir. 1995); *White v. City of Norwalk*, 900 F.2d 1421, 1425-26 (9th Cir. 1990).
 - The OML does not "[p]revent the removal of any person who willfully disrupts a meeting to the extent that its orderly conduct is made impractical." NRS 241.030(4)(a).

VIOLATIONS OF THE OML

- Actions taken in violation of the law are void. NRS 241.036.
- The OAG has statutory enforcement powers under the OML and the authority to investigate and prosecute violations of the OML. NRS 241.037; NRS 241.039; NRS 241.040.
- When a violation of the OML occurs or is alleged, the OAG recommends that the public body made every effort to promptly correct the apparent violation. NRS 241.0365.
- Although it may not completely eliminate the violation, corrective action can mitigate the severity of the violation and further ensure that the business of government is accomplished in the open.
- Corrective action is prospective only. NRS 241.0365(4).
 - Corrective action requires that the public body engage in an independent deliberative action in full compliance with the OML. See, e.g., *Page v. MiraCosta Community College Dist.*, 102 Cal. Rptr. 3rd 902, 930 (Cal. Ct. App. 2009).
 - A public body must clearly denote that corrective action may be taken at a meeting by placing the term "for possible corrective action" next to the appropriate agenda item. NRS 241.020(2)(d)(2).

USING TECHNOLOGY FOR A MEETING

- Quorum of a public body using serial electronic communication to deliberate toward or make a decision violates law. NRS 241.016(4); *Del Papa v. Board of Regents*, 114 Nev. 388, 956 P.2d 770 (1998).
- If technology is used to convene a quorum for a public meeting:
 - There must always be a physical location for members of the public to attend the meeting. NRS 241.020(1); AB 70.
 - All the members of the public body and the members of the public who are present at the meeting must be able to hear or observe and participate in the meeting. NRS 241.010(2);
 - That technology must not be used to circumvent the spirit or letter of the OML. NRS 241.016(4)

Additional Points

- Meeting held to recognize or award positive achievements of a person is not subject to the notice requirements of NRS 241.033.
- The OAG will not investigate complaints about alleged violations that occurred more than 120 days before the complaint was filed, unless: (1) Violation was not discoverable at the time the violation occurred, and (2) The alleged violation did not occur more than 1 year prior to the complaint
- The OAG has authority to decline to investigate if it determines that the interests of the complainant are not significantly affected by the alleged violation, unless:
 - Complainant would have standing in a court of law, and
 - Complainant is (1) a natural person who resides in the jurisdiction of the public body; or (2) a non-governmental entity with a mission to foster or promote transparency in government
- If a member of public body relies on legal advice, no criminal penalty or administrative fine may be imposed.
- Disclosure and abstention prior to consideration of a topic in conformance with Ethics in Government Law (NRS Chapter 281A). Abstain only in a clear case where the independence of judgement of a reasonable person in your situation would be materially affected by the conflict of interest disclosed. See NRS 281A.420;

What is a Public Record?

- ❖ All state agency records are public <u>unless</u> declared confidential by law. *See* NRS 239.010.
- Under the NPRA, information is by <u>default</u> public record <u>unless</u> specific confidentiality restrictions apply.
- ❖ The NPRA allows both written and verbal requests for public records. See NRS 239.0107(1).
 - ❖ Note: Extraordinary requests <u>must</u> be in writing. See NRS 239.055. Depends on size of agency, volume of records, etc.
 - ❖ E.g.: verbal request for an agenda at a public meeting; email requests for minutes following a public meeting.

NEVADA PUBLIC RECORDS ACT (NPRA)

- Statutes codified in NRS Chapter 239
- * Regulations codified in NAC Chapter 239
- General Framework to use when responding to public record requests:
 - ❖ 1. Is the agency in possession of potentially responsive records that are readily accessible?
 - 2. If yes, are there any confidentiality requirements per statute that prevent disclosure?
 - ❖ 3. If no confidentiality requirements are present for the subject record request(s), the default generally applies with a consideration for public interest regarding the information.

Main Premise of the NPRA

- ❖ The NPRA favors:
 - Transparency in Government
 - Open Access to agency records; and
 - Liberal construction of statutory text in order to maximize the public's right of access to agency records.

Main Premise of the NPRA (Cont.)

- * "The Legislature has declared that the purpose of the NPRA is to further the democratic ideal of an accountable government by ensuring that the public records are broadly accessible. See Reno Newspapers, Inc., v. Jim Gibbons, Governor of the State of Nevada, 127 Nev. Adv. Op, at 5 (citing NRS 239.001(1)).
- * Records requested must be (1) identifiable and (2) not overbroad.
- Records should be presumed to be public unless a specific statute provides for confidentiality.

Determining Whether to Deny Request or Withhold Records

- ❖ 1. Does a Regulatory or Statutory Confidentiality Provision apply?
 - ❖ See State Statute: NRS 239.010
 - Any applicable State Regulations
 - ❖ Any applicable Federal Regulations
 - Any applicable Case Law
- ❖ 2. If none of the above apply to justify denial or withholding records, then apply the *Bradshaw* Balancing Test.

Determining Whether to Deny Request or Withhold Records (Cont.)

- Donrey of Nevada, Inc., and Reno Newspapers v. Robert Bradshaw, 798 P.2d 144 (1990).
- Absent any statutory or regulatory authorities declaring the requested records as confidential, the Nevada Supreme Court requires the agency to weigh the agency's interests in non-disclosure against the general policy in favor of open government and the requestor's fundamental right to access of public records.
- The <u>burden</u> rests with the agency to explain why the records requested should not be furnished with specific evidence justifying the withholding of the records.
- Government interest in withholding must "clearly" outweigh the public's interest in disclosure.


Determining Whether to Deny Request or Withhold Records (Cont.)

- Common privileges, statutes and case law that have been used as a reference to justify nondisclosure or at the very least, the application of narrowly tailored redactions:
 - **Attorney Client Privilege**
 - **❖** NRS 49.095
 - Wardleigh v. Second Judicial Dist. Court In & For Cty. of Washoe, 111 Nev. 345, 357, 891 P.2d 1180, 1188 (1995).
 - **Deliberative Process:** records containing opinions, recommendations, or advice about agency policies.
 - ❖ DR Partners v. Board of County Commissioners,116 Nev. 616, 619-29, 6 P.3d 465, 467-73 (2000).
 - **Law Enforcement sensitive**-balancing test to be applied
 - Donrey of Nevada, Inc. v. Bradshaw, 798 P.2d 144 (1990).
 - * Reno Newspapers, Inc. v. Gibbons, 127 Nev. at 880, 266 P.3d at 628 (2011).
 - Personal privacy information-balancing test to be applied
 - Clark County School District v. Las Vegas Review Journal, 34 Nev. 700, 429 P.3d 313 (2018).
 - Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department v. Las Vegas Review-Journal 136 Nev. Adv. Op. 86 (2020).

Additional Scrutiny for Public Agencies to Consider:

- ❖ Las Vegas Review Journal v. Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (Issued March 30, 2023)
- * References to "significant" and "compelling" public interests in disclosure of internal investigative records, including whether the law enforcement agency appropriately handled an investigation that did not result in criminal charges.
- Ultimately, we determine that this will likely result in more scrutiny of agency confidentiality assertions, not just those in law enforcement.

Additional Scrutiny for Public Agencies to Consider:



Response Requirements

Writing Required:

An agency must respond in writing to records requests no later than five (5) business days from the date of receipt.

***** Three options:

- (1) Provide the records requested either by giving a copy or allowing the requester to inspect the records;
- ❖ (2) Provide the date when we <u>anticipate</u> that the records will be available; or
- ❖ (3) Inform the requester that the agency does not have the requested records and provide the name and contact for the government entity that does have the records, if known.
- ❖ If a public record is readily available, in lieu of a written response the agency shall allow the requestor to inspect, copy or receive a copy of the record.
- Do you have a public records policy and procedure to ensure that you are meeting this time frame?
 - **YES!** (1) Executive Director oversees and completes the gathering, (2) Executive Director/Board Staff gather requests pertaining to emails and records in the Board's possession, (3) Board counsel drafts all correspondence to the requester and complete all reviews, (4) Board counsel and Executive Director track upcoming deadlines.

Recover Actual Costs

- An agency may recover its actual costs in providing a copy of a public record to the requestor. NRS 239.052.
- ❖ Providing copies of public records to the public is deemed part of the agency's regular duties. Thus, these costs generally may include only actual costs such as, those for toner, paper and postage, and not employee time in responding to the request, unless the request is extraordinary.

No Charge for Minutes and Recordings of Meetings

- Minutes of public meetings are public records.
- ❖ Minutes or audiotape recordings of the meetings must be made available for inspection by the Public within 30 working days after the adjournment of the meeting and a copy of the minutes or audio must be available to the public upon request at no charge. NRS 241.035(2).
- ❖ All agencies must have five years of minutes(retention requirement). The remainder may be sent to State Archives. See NRS 241.035(2).

List of Fees

- ❖ The agency must prepare and maintain a list of its fees for providing public records, which should be posted in a conspicuous place in each of its offices. NRS 239.052(3).
- ❖ If applicable, the agency's list of fees must also include per page fee for court reporter transcripts. NRS 239.053(2).

District Court Review

- ❖ Pursuant to NRS 239.011, if a public record request is denied by the agency, the requestor may apply to the District Court in the county where the book or record is located for an Order:
 - ❖ (1) Permitting the requestor to inspect or copy the book or record; or
 - ❖ (2) Requiring the agency who has legal custody or control of the public book or record to provide a copy to the requestor.

Record Retention and Archiving

- At the appropriate time according to your Records Retention Schedule:
 - Destroy securely or
 - Send to State Library and Archives
 - ❖ For more information: https://nsla.nv.gov/home click on "Records Management" at the top, then "State Agencies", and then look for the retention schedule you need.



- New Board Members will submit financial disclosure forms
- Board Members are PROHIBITED from soliciting or accepting anything of value if doing so might influence a reasonable person to no longer act impartially.
 - o THINK!
 - -Would I ask Board Staff to do this for me if I wasn't a Board member?
 - -Ultimatums- "If you don't do Xfor me...I'm going to use my position to do Y"
 - "The rules don't apply to me because of my position on the Board."

Open Meeting Law (OML)

- All of the Board's meetings must be public
 - Notice posted 3 working days before the meeting
 - Written minutes posted 30 days after the meeting





III. Matters that Appear Before the Board





When a licensee or salon owner disagrees with a citation that has been issued to them or their salon they may submit a...

Petition to appear before the Board." (NAC 644A940)

Petitioning for NRS/NAC Legislation Changes

Example: "Jane thinks that the Board of Cosmetology should have a "lash license" and that should be separate from an esthetics or cosmetology license."

- Staff recommends this be brought up during public comment
- If the Board likes the idea consider putting in on an Law Review Agenda
- *Remember- Public Comment is a 1-sided conversation...a petitioner may bring up anything, but the Board should refrain from engaging in a Q&A

Petitioning due to Licensing Application Denial

The most common denials that we have are from individuals who went to an out-of-state or out-of-country school that has either closed or has been flagged as "suspect" by the Nevada BOC or another state's BOC.

- Petitioners get a letter stating WHY their application has been rejected
 - That letter contains information on WHATWENEED to see to reconsider the application (For example: Time cards from his or her school)
- When petitioners come before the Board, please be mindful that it doesn't advance the ball to have them reach back out to Board staff if they're unable to produce the documents requested.


Petitioning to Complain

Most petitioners file because they would like a citation waived.

- All petitions are reviewed by Board staff prior to meetings (i.e. if we can rectify a situation before it appears before the Board, we try and do so)
- The position of the Board Staff is that a clean salon needs no justification.
- Be mindful of why you're reducing a citation.
 - Is it an arbitrary amount?
 - Why are you reducing the citation?

- What is it?- You have a motion on the table, but you want to change the wording of the motion (EG maybe the motion said payable in 30 days and others think payable in 60 days)
- When do you do it? After a motion has been made and then seconded, you'll have a discussion period. During discussion other Board members may have thrown out good ideas that should be incorporated into the motion.



Amending Motions

AMENDMENT

What if we have 2+changes we want me make?- You can make as many changes (amendments) you want to the motion, but you have to deal with then one at a time.



<u>How do we vote on the amendment?</u> During DISCUSSION step, a Board member will say "I move to amend the motion.."

- Another Board Member will "Second" the amendment
- The period for DISCUSSION will begin
- Members will VOIE on the amendment
 - Note: You still have to vote on the main motion...you're just voting on the amendment
