SALON OPENING CHECKLIST

If you can answer "YES" to the following questions, you are ready to submit your new salon application!

Is there a working exhaust system (central heating and cooling with a vent in the restroom)?	
Are the restrooms operational with non-porous floors?	
Are the dispensary sinks permanently plumbed and operational with non-porous floors? (Note! A dispensary sink is used for hand washing and cleaning implements. Shampoo bowls and restroom sinks do not qualify as dispensary sinks.)	
Does the salon have signage matching the business name?	
Are all sinks and/or sources of water operational with hot and cold running water?	
Are the salon's ceilings, equipment, fixtures, floors, furnishings, and walls clean and in good repair?	
Are there covered trash cans present in the salon?	
Are the towels/linens stored in closed, dust-free containers/cabinets?	
Does the salon have disinfectant and sanitation products present?	
Is the licensee in charge present at the time of the opening inspection?	
If applicable, a sign indicating that the establishment is not a medical facility.	

**Please be aware that a citation of \$1,000 will be issued to the salon and unlicensed individual for practicing in the salon without a current NV license.*
