## **SALON OPENING CHECKLIST**

If you can answer "YES" to the following questions, you are ready to submit your new salon application!

Is there a working exhaust system (central heating and cooling with a vent in the restroom)?	<b>✓</b>
Are the restrooms operational with non-porous floors?	<u> </u>
Are the dispensary sinks permanently plumbed and operational with non-porous floors? (Note! A dispensary sink is used for hand washing and cleaning implements. Shampoo bowls and restroom sinks do not qualify as dispensary sinks.)	<u> </u>
Does the salon have signage matching the business name?	<b>√</b>
Are all sinks and/or sources of water operational with hot and cold running water?	<b>₹</b>
Are the salon's ceilings, equipment, fixtures, floors, furnishings, and walls clean and in good repair?	<b>✓</b>
Are there covered trash cans present in the salon?	<b>✓</b>
Are the towels/linens stored in closed, dust-free containers/cabinets?	<b>₹</b>
Does the salon have disinfectant and sanitation products present?	<b>✓</b>
Is the licensee in charge present at the time of the opening inspection?	<u> </u>
If applicable, a sign indicating that the establishment is not a medical facility.	<b>✓</b>
