

The 75 hour laser course guidelines:

- Taught inside an establishment or school licensed to offer advanced esthetics.
- Instruction must be provided by a licensed advanced esthetician with an active collaboration agreement or a licensed health care professional as defined in NRS 453C.030.
- An active notarized collaboration agreement must be on file for the supervision of the students in the course by a licensed health care professional as defined in NRS 453C.030.
- If instruction is provided by a licensed advanced esthetician, their experience must be verified by the Board staff. You will need to submit proof of hands-on experience / training in lasers by way of certificate or notarized practical experience. This will need to be included in your laser course packet you submit for review.
- The laser course can be offered in person or as a hybrid (online). Hybrid is not mandatory.
- **Hybrid classes can offer no more than 20 hours of online instruction.**
- Hybrid hours of online instruction must be verifiable through the platform or online medium used and provided to Board staff.
- Hours of in person instruction must be verified by the course provider and provided to Board staff.
- In person hours of instruction should be in groups of no more than 5 students to 1 a licensed advanced esthetic course provider.
- Verified hours of Hybrid / In person sign in sheets of instruction are to be sent to info@nvcosmo.com

The curriculum of the course must include, but is not limited to,

15 hours in Laser Safety:

Laser Safety Officer, Laser Physics, Laser settings and functionalities, Exposure Levels, Device Maintenance and Service Protocols, Responsibilities of Operators, Radiation, Hazards, Laws and Regulations (State and Federal), Health Care Professional Supervision, FDA and OSHA regulations/requirements.

10 hours in Safety and Sanitation:

Safety Measures, Equipment, and Precautions, CPR Training, Sanitation/Sterilization/Disinfection processes

15 hours in hours in Skin Theory:

Skin Anatomy and Physiology, Skin Analyzing, Skin Conditions, Diseases and disorders of the skin, Contraindications, Fitzpatrick scale, Lancer Ethnicity Scale, Treatment Outcomes, Burns and Reactions

5 hours in Pre and Post Treatment Protocols

Consultations, Identify/Understand/Recognize potential safety issues, complications, and contraindications during a laser service

30 hours in one or more of the following hands on procedures:

Hair Reduction,

Skin Rejuvenation,

Non-Ablative Skin Resurfacing,

Spider Vein Reduction,

Skin Tightening,

Wrinkle Reduction

Non-Ablative Tattoo Removal

Solar Lentigo Reduction (Age Spots)

Ephelis Reduction (Freckles)

Acne Scar Reduction,

Or Additional non ablative procedures as approved by the Board or its designee
