Dear Licensees, Registrants, and Students:

During the COVID-19 closures, the Nevada State Board of Cosmetology worked hard to maintain remote services and to provide relevant information to assist businesses in reopening. We answered nearly 6,000 phone calls with an answer rate of 85% and we sent/responded to nearly 100,000 emails from individuals seeking licensing or informational services. We established the Enhanced Sanitation Guidelines in Response to COVID-19 along with health and safety infographics and videos in 4 different languages that were collectively viewed nearly 90,000 times. Nearly 200,000 emails were sent to licensees and registrants keeping them updated on evolving COVID-19 information.

The Nevada State Board of Cosmetology remains committed to providing beauty service industry participants with quality licensing, testing, inspection, and education services as we reopen our offices.

Here's Our Reopening Plan

- All licensing, compliance, and informational services will remain available online and over the phone only.
- Our offices will reopen on June 3, 2020, for theory testing services only. If you were already scheduled to take your practical or theory test with the Board prior to the COVID-19 closures we will notify you of your test date by phone or email. If you do not hear from us by Monday, June 8, 2020, regarding your updated test date, please email us at vegastesting@nvcosmo.com.
- If you are a student at a Nevada school of cosmetology and you were not scheduled for the theory test prior to the COVID-19 closure, you must contact your school to be scheduled.

- Practical tests for out of state/country applicants will resume on Monday, June 15, 2020. We will notify you of your test date by phone or email on or before Thursday, June 11, 2020.
- In-office licensing, compliance, and informational services will resume on Monday, June 15, 2020
- Testing services will operate at 40% capacity to accommodate social distancing requirements.

Office Visitor Requirements

- Visitors are required to practice social distancing.
- Visitors must wear a face-covering out of respect for staff and other visitors. If you do not wish to wear a face-covering, we encourage you to revisit our offices after Gov. Sisolak announces that face-coverings are no longer recommended in public spaces.
- Visitors should not come to the Board office if they have been potentially exposed to COVID-19 or in close proximity to anyone who has COVID-19 in the last 2 weeks.
- Visitors should not come to the Board office if they currently have a temperature/fever.
- Visitors should not come to the Board office if they are showing any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Only testing applicants with scheduled test dates will be permitted in the office from June 3, 2020, until June 11, 2020.
