### Executive Director's Corner

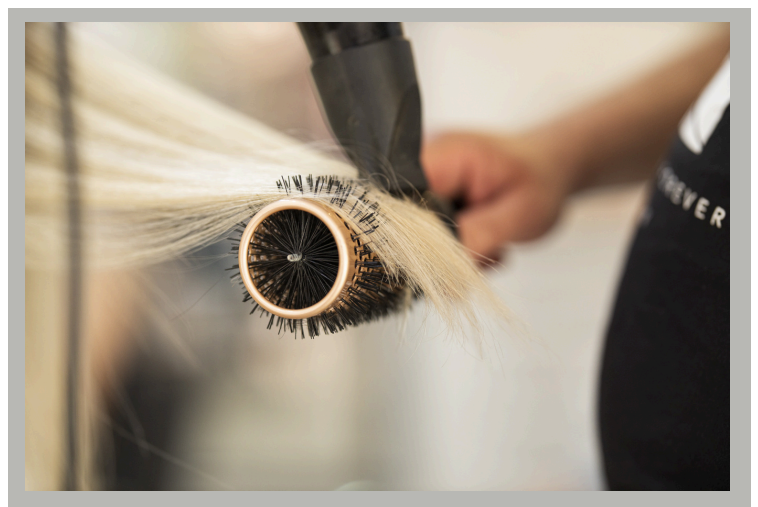

In continuing our education and compliance efforts, we have instituted a Certificate of Compliance program recognizing the great efforts of establishment and school licensees in aiding the Nevada State Board of Cosmetology in protecting the health and safety of the public by not having any citations/violations at the location or by the individual licensees at that location for two (2) straight quarters. We are proud to recognize those efforts as well as to bring this education newsletter and information directly to you. Cheers!



### Student and Instructor Communication:

As a student, you are not able to work from home. You **MUST** provide services at your school while under the supervision of your instructors. This is pursuant to NAC 644A.618 which also includes that instructors **MUST** devote their full time during the hours they are on duty as an instructor.

Instructors, how are you incorporating your students into your clinic? Are you having the student manage the school clinic books and social media pages?



## **School Communication:**

### **\*NEW REGULATION ALERT\***

Students must be entered into the portal within 30 days of being enrolled or re-enrollment. A \$100 citation will be issued for each student not enrolled within 30 days.

When students are re-enrolling or transferring hours, a letter of credit **MUST** be issued before the student is enrolled pursuant to NAC 644A.640. Only school administrators can request letters of credit from our website.

## **Licensee Communication:**

Pursuant to NRS 644A.510, licensees must notify the Board of their work locations. Working from home is illegal per NRS 644A.900 and it is a citable offense. Operating a salon out of your home without an establishment license, pursuant to NRS 644A.600/NRS 644A.900, is a \$1000 first offense citation. In addition to the violation above, you would also be failing to comply with NAC 644A.810, by not practicing in a location not authorized by the Board this is a \$500 first offense citation.

### **\*NEW REGULATION ALERT\***

If you are a licensed Advanced Esthetician and are providing services that require medical professional supervision, you need to have a collaboration agreement. This is a citable offense if there is no collaboration of supervision with a medical professional. The first offense is a \$1000 citation.



## Board Highlights:

The Nevada State Board of Cosmetology will now issue compliance certificates to salon and spa establishments and schools who have had two or more consecutive inspections without any individual or establishment violations. This achievement demonstrates a high level of commitment to sanitation, safety and regulatory compliance from both the establishment and the individual licensees working within it. ## Did you know...

Anyone can turn in unlicensed activity! If you know an individual or establishment that is performing service unlicensed or outside of their scope, you can file the complaint on our website. Go to [NVCOSMO.COM](http://NVCOSMO.COM) and click "File A Complaint".

MMA is prohibited to be on the premises pursuant to NAC 644A.805. If MMA is found on the premise, the first offense is a \$1000 citation.

Graters, credo blades, callus shavers, and other implements which are used to remove corns or calluses are prohibited from being on the premises pursuant to NAC 644A.805. If these implements are found on the premise, the first offense is a \$1000 citation.

Keep everyone safe while performing laser services. There should be no reflective surfaces in rooms where lasers are being used. You should also make sure there are no openings in the walls or ceiling for reflective surfaces. Any laser services are required to be performed under the supervision of a medical professional.

Top 3 violations issued by the Compliance Department are failing to post the establishment license, failing to use disinfectant properly, and invasive procedures with having a grater on-premise.
