## **Here's What's New**

Governor Sisolak announced the release of the [Nevada United Roadmap to Recovery](#) plan on April 30, 2020. This plan has provided the Nevada State Board of Cosmetology with guidance on how to submit the Board of Cosmetology's [Enhanced Sanitation Guidelines for Salons in Response to COVID-19](#) to the appropriate decision-makers.

There is no established date for businesses that deliver hair, nail, and skin care services to reopen. LEAP, Governor Sisolak, and the Medical Advisory Team (MAT) will review data to determine if the statewide criteria are met in order for a phased opening to occur.
